How to write a wiki

The idea of a wiki is to write articles together. For example, if somebody starts writing about typical film beginnings of comedies, the others can make corrections and comment on the entry.

As a group, you will publish a film encyclopedia which will come handy when you write your reviews later in this course.

Your entry should include

- headings and subheadings
- paragraphs (new idea = new paragraph)
- basic and focused journalistic information
- concise and comprehensive language, well-chosen nouns, strong verbs, main sentences
- neutral and jargon-free language, with explanations provided for specialized terminology, no colloqualism, no bias
- sources and links, don't quote from other texts without reference

If you make a comment, do this is in a friendly and helpful way.
